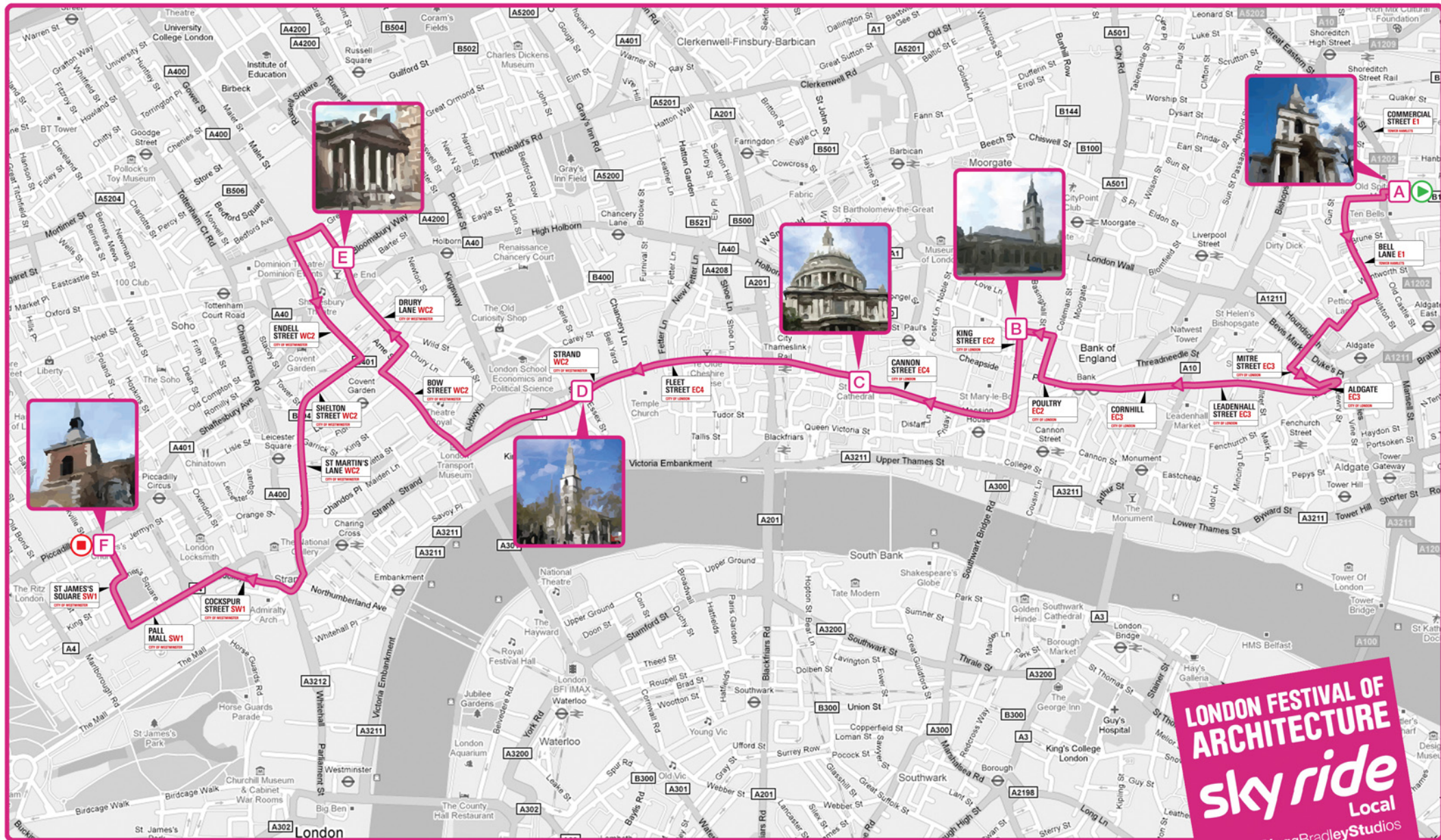


# LFA Sky Rides: Wren & Hawksmoor Churches with Fergus Connolly

A tour of several city churches built in the wake of the Great Fire of London, in particular those of Christopher Wren and Nicholas Hawksmoor. The ride will consider the unique historic context of these architectural gems in terms of religion, arts, and the city, and seeks to illustrate their continual relevance and value in those areas.

## Additional Navigational Notes

### RIDE FEATURES

#### CHRIST CHURCH (Fournier Street)



### DIRECTIONS

#### START

- **SITE OF FIRST TALK**
- Left down Crispin Street
- Onto Bell Lane
- Right onto Cobb Lane to end
- Left onto Middlesex Street
- Right onto Gravel Lane
- Dogleg left then right onto Stonely St
- Cross Houndsditch
- Cross Dukes Place
- Proceed down Creechurch
- Sharp Left onto Mitre Street
- Left onto Aldgate (one way only)
- **BEFORE** first set of traffic lights, take small cycle lane on your right hand side
- Cycle lane cuts through the central reservation
- When safe to do so, turn right (back on yourself) along Aldgate
- Filter right onto Leadenhall Street, follow to end
- Cross Bishopsgate onto Cornhill
- Follow Cornhill to end, to Bank Junction
- Cross junction straight ahead, onto Poultry
- Take first available right hand turn onto Old Jewry, follow to end
- Turn left onto Gresham Street
- Church is on right hand side, next to entrance to Guildhall square

#### ST LAWRENCE JEWRY



- **SITE OF SECOND TALK**, next to Guildhall
- Return back along Gresham Street
- First right onto King Street
- Straight over at lights onto Queen St to end
- Bear right onto Queen Victoria Street
- At next junction, take right fork onto Cannon St
- Proceed ahead to St Paul's Cathedral on right

#### ST PAULS CATHEDRAL



- **SITE OF THIRD TALK**
- Rejoin Ludgate Hill outside St Pauls
- Continue on Ludgate Hill, crossing large road
- Proceed onto Fleet Street
- Proceed onto the Strand
- Turn left down Essex Street (facing Royal Courts of Justice) to dismount safely

### RIDE FEATURES

#### ST CLEMENTS DANES



- **SITE OF FOURTH TALK**
- Continue along Strand
- Take right hand fork in road but stay left
- Stay in left hand lane
- At lights, careful turn left onto Wellington St
- Continue straight up Wellington St
- Onto Bow Street
- Left at roundabout (allowed to bikes) onto Long Acre
- Next left onto Drury Lane
- Cross High Holborn at junction onto Museum St
- At next junction, turn right onto Bloomsbury Way

#### ST GEORGE'S CHURCH



- **SITE OF FIFTH TALK**
- Continue up Museum Place to the left side of the church
- Left onto Great Russell Street
- Third left onto Bloomsbury St, crossing New Oxford Street and Shaftesbury Ave
- Turn right onto High Holborn then immediate left onto Endell Street
- Second right onto Shelton Street to end
- Left onto St Martin's Lane to end
- Join Charing Cross Road to large roundabout
- Take final exit off roundabout onto Cockspur Street/Trafalgar Square
- **NOTE:** you may prefer to dismount and walk your bike across Trafalgar Square
- At end of Cockspur St, proceed onto Pall Mall
- Take right hand entrance onto St James's Square Gardens
- Take north exit from Square onto Duke of York Street to end
- Left onto Jermyn Street

#### ST JAMES'S CHURCH



- Rear entrance to St James's Church is ahead on the right
