


LFA Sky Rides: Biodiversity in the City with Sarah Price

The tour celebrates how gardens and parks have kept biodiversity alive in cities, providing rich experiences for wildlife and people. The ride will explore potential ways of bringing nature right into the heart of towns and cities. Unlike many wildlife gardens these sites are neither scruffy nor unkempt but are designed to be breathtakingly beautiful in their planting. The tour moves from the Olympic site in Stratford, through Mile End Park, along the Thames and into Covent Garden. This map gives an overview of the route only. Accompanying navigational notes are also available to download.

Additional Navigational Notes

RIDE FEATURES	DIRECTIONS	RIDE FEATURES	DIRECTIONS
VIEW TUBE 2012 	START ■ Meet at View Tube on Pudding Mill Lane SITE OF FIRST TALK ■ Depart along the cycle path heading west ■ Take cycle path to end ■ Join Wick Lane and pass under the railway bridge ■ Cross over canal bridge then turn right onto Towpath ■ Turn back underneath the canal bridge to head west ■ Follow towpath alongside Victoria Park ■ Where towpaths meet at canal junction, take the left fork onto Regents Canal heading south ■ Continue along towpath to Mile End Park	POTTERS FIELD PARK 	SITE OF FOURTH TALK ■ Leave park via Potter's Field Lane onto Tooley St ■ Right onto Tooley Street ■ Immediate left onto Druid St, cross pedestrian island on cycle path ■ Bear right onto Crucifix Lane ■ Proceed onto St Thomas Street to end ■ Left onto Borough High Street ■ Filter into right hand turn lane ■ Turn right with lights onto Southwark St to end ■ At junction, stay in right hand lane ■ Turn right onto Blackfriars Road ■ BEFORE the bridge road begins, turn left onto Upper Ground ■ Continue along Upper Ground, passing under Waterloo Bridge ■ Immediately after passing under Waterloo Bridge, turn left up Waterloo Road ■ Use cycle lane to travel up the ramp then give way at the end ■ Left onto Waterloo Bridge ■ Stay left in bus lane while crossing the bridge ■ Move into right hand lane when road becomes Lancaster Place ■ At lights, cross the box junction – DO NOT TURN FULL RIGHT ■ Instead, go straight on carefully up the cycle path into Wellington St ■ Continue up Wellington St onto Bow Street ■ Cross Long Acre onto Endell Street ■ First left onto Shelton Street ■ First major right onto Mercer Street ■ Cross Seven Dials roundabout back onto Mercer St ■ At end, turn left on Shaftesbury Avenue ■ First right onto Stacey Street
MILE END PARK 	SITE OF SECOND TALK ■ Continue along towpath, passing under: Mile End Road Bridge Solebay St Bridge Past Ragged School Museum Pass under Ben Johnson Road bridge ■ Leave towpath at next exit on the left ■ Turn left onto Rhodeswell Road, crossing canal again ■ Continue onto Ben Johnson Road to junction ■ Left onto Stepney High Street ■ Bear first right onto Stepney Way, then immediate left onto Bromley Street to end ■ Right onto Commercial Road ■ Immediate left onto Carline (?) Street to end ■ Right onto Cable Street ■ Continue down Cable Street, passing left turn onto Brodlove Lane ■ Next left onto Glamis Road ■ Continue onto Wapping Wall ■ Continue onto Wapping High Street ■ Hermitage Community Moorings is situated at Hermitage Wharf, located at the entrance to the former London Docks.	PHOENIX GARDENS 	SITE OF FINAL TALK END
HERMITAGE MOORINGS 	SITE OF THIRD TALK ■ At end of Wapping High St, turn right at junction onto Thomas More St ■ Follow this street as it bears left, to end ■ Left onto East Smithfield ■ Left onto Tower Bridge approach ■ Cross Tower Bridge
